TORNADO HUNTER IN MOOSE JAW TO DISCUSS PUBLIC SAFETY

More information about storm safety is needed to protect lives during severe weather. Tornado presentation will provide in-site into storms, tornadoes and how to stay safe.

The storms of 2010 left many Saskatchewan residents wondering ‘could this get any worse’? The answer is yes. Severe weather is on the rise and that fact has been hammered home by tornadoes like the one that struck the Raymore, SK area in July of 2010. Extreme, violent and often deadly weather has shaped our news in the past few years. Storm Photographer and self proclaimed Tornado Hunter Greg Johnson has witnessed many tornadoes and seen their effects on communities. April 9th he will be in Moose Jaw at The Sportsmans Center (276 Home St. E.) presenting *Tornado Hunting – The Art of Storm Chasing*

“We will see more tornadoes in Saskatchewan this year” Johnson says “I have always been passionate about severe weather and when you see what a tornado can do to a home or an entire town, it really is devastating. People need to know more about what to do when severe weather strikes.”

A man from Saskatchewan was killed by a tornado about an hour south of Estevan in August of 2010. And with Severe weather season just around the corner, now is the time to get the knowledge you need to stay safe.

Dallas Hicks a NAV CANADA meteorologist in Regina says “Greg’s enthusiasm for severe weather and dedication to educating people about safety is noteworthy. People do need to know more about this topic and anyone interested in Photography or Tornadoes should see this presentation.”
